

## FOR THE PATIENT EXPERIENCING CHEST PAIN [CHESTPAIN]

Drug Allergy

Date

Hour

1. Notify Rapid Response team.
2. STAT EKG, CK Total, CKMB, Troponin 1.
3. Saline lock if no IV access.
4. After EKG obtained, NTG 0.4 mg SL q5 minutes up to 3 tabs prn for chest pain. Hold if systolic B/P <100.
5. Nasal O2 at 2LPM, titrate to keep O2 saturation 90% or greater.
6. Notify physician of current assessment, vital signs and above actions taken. Have patient chart, current medication list and labs available when calling physician.
7. Nurse should not delay calling the attending physician because of waiting on lab results.
