Apply For A Sitter Position

What does a Sitter do?

A sitter performs a one-on-one observation of a patient, duties included but not limited to: documentation, providing frequent support to current needs, assist with re-positioning in bed and ambulation, engage in conversation, and provide emotional support.

- » To be eligible to be a sitter you must work part-time or contingent and total hours for the pay period must not result in full-time hours or over-time.
- » You do not have to be in the nursing department.
- » Sitter will be scheduled regular shifts each pay period – mostly evening and night shift and weekends. 8 hour shifts are preferred.
- » Must complete sitter orientation before being scheduled and be able to perform the essential functions of the job.
- » Must meet Education requirements.
GED or HS Diploma Required.
